Quality policy

Acquisition of ISO certification

For better maintenance/control of our quality system in pursuing the policy above, ISO9001 certification was acquired by the Kyushu Office on December 22, 1999 and by the Tochigi Plant on October 9, 2015. Further, on September 15, 2017, the transition of ISO 9001: 2015 version was completed. To protect the environment, the Tochigi Plant acquired ISO14001 certification on March 1, 2002. On March 16, 2018, the transition of ISO 14001: 2015 version was completed as well.

Conflict-free procurement

Gold, tin, tungsten, and tantalum produced in the Democratic Republic of the Congo and its neighboring countries can be considered "conflict minerals" that are exploited by armed groups as a source of funding through trade, and which could result in infringement of human rights and destruction of the environment.

Nippon Leakless Corporation pursues its policy of conducting a survey in compliance with the EICC/GeSI Conflict Minerals Report Template, and rules out the procurement of materials that include conflict minerals (conflict free).
